Effective 3/1/2025

- Generic Preventive Medications will remain a \$0 copay
- Brand Preventive Medications (including diabetics) will now bypass the deductible and pay at your plan coverage of 20% coinsurance for 30-day (\$200 max) & 90-day (\$400 max) prescriptions.

How do I access this new coverage?

The Preventive Drug List is part of your plan. All you need to do is present your CVS Caremark® member ID card at the pharmacy when you fill your prescriptions. Your pharmacy will then automatically charge you your plan's applicable copay or coinsurance when you fill any medication on this list. If a medication you take regularly is not on the list, just ask your doctor if a listed medication might be right for you.
